The lowdown on lineups at music fests

JUNE 1-5 MONTREAL

Mutek: There are dozens of music festivals where you can see the same old acts that show up everywhere. Then there's Mutek, a carefully curated collection of musical acts from the Americas and Europe. Mutek is a not-forprofit festival, meaning organizers are less concerned with

pulling in superstars than with promoting Quebec talent and scouring the globe for electronicbased buzz bands that are either criminally underappreciated, or about to break big. The 2011 edition features Actress, Ben Frost, Brandt Brauer Frick, Carl Michael von Hausswolff, D Numbers, Eleh, Matmos, Minilogue, Moritz von Oswald Trio, Mouse

on Mars, Nurse With Wound, Paul Kalkbrenner, Pépé Bradock, Rebolledo, Señor Coconut and His Orchestra, and Vladislav Delay. A festival pass is \$182. www.mutek.org

JUNE 24-26 ATLANTIC CITY **Dave Matthews Band Caravan:** Generally the words Dave Mat-

thews and Atlantic City would leave us seeking shelter elsewhere. But the Dave Matthews Band Caravan is not as frightening as it sounds (please, hold your hate mail). The three-day festival takes place in a number of venues across the casino-filled city and includes sets from the Flaming Lips, David Gray, Ray LaMontagne, Grace Potter and the Nocturnals, Guster, Amos Lee, Damian Marley, and Thievery Corporation. There's also a Dave Matthews and Tim Reynolds acoustic set, for those of you who like that sort of thing. General admission for the festival is \$195, a VIP pass \$825. www.dmbcaravan.com

A Great Night in Harlem: It
